5	<p data-bbox="261 219 539 250"><u>Commodore's Report</u></p> <p data-bbox="261 291 932 322">Brian Fraser highlighted the following in his report:</p> <ul data-bbox="312 362 1396 1827" style="list-style-type: none"> <li data-bbox="312 362 1396 465">• The club now has a formal arrangement with Dunecht Estates for the Stonehaven beach dinghy park and pays £300/year rent on a 3 year rolling contract.</li> <li data-bbox="312 472 1396 544">• Wire cables have been installed in the dinghy park for tying boats down, but this has not been actively taken up by club members.</li> <li data-bbox="312 551 884 582">• Intended to erect barrier to Dinghy Park.</li> <li data-bbox="312 589 1396 692">• At Loch of Skene the club has maintained its excellent relationship with Dunecht estates and the Estate is keen for ASYC to continue to have exclusive use of the Boathouse and dinghy parking facilities there.</li> <li data-bbox="312 698 1396 801">• For the outdoor access legislation, separate access for other water users is being looked at. The channel in front of gatehouse has been deepened and the dinghy parking area is to be further flattened for next season.</li> <li data-bbox="312 808 1396 947">• The Junior sailing has been very successful with 60 children as Junior sailors this year. The Committee is looking at restricting numbers to 30 with club member's children having priority and increasing Junior membership fees to £20.</li> <li data-bbox="312 954 1396 1025">• Membership numbers are very healthy with the highest ever membership and an increase of 17% on last year.</li> <li data-bbox="312 1032 1374 1064">• The racing this year has been very successful with new members supporting it.</li> <li data-bbox="312 1070 1374 1102">• Accounts are in a very good position and ably looked after by John Colegrave.</li> <li data-bbox="312 1108 1396 1180">• There was a lower turn out at the open regatta than expected possibly due to weather and some classes not turning up in the numbers expected.</li> <li data-bbox="312 1187 1396 1258">• For next years regatta the committee is looking at a tally system to keep a check on who is out on the water.</li> <li data-bbox="312 1265 1396 1337">• The work on the clubhouse has been finished at last and the Committee is now looking at the dinghy park shed as next building requiring attention.</li> <li data-bbox="312 1344 1110 1375">• A powerboat instructor's course is planned at Stonehaven.</li> <li data-bbox="312 1382 1396 1485">• A major issue has been boat parking, not storage at Stonehaven and towards the end of the season had to advise new members that they could not store their boat at Stonehaven.</li> <li data-bbox="312 1491 1396 1563">• The issue of space at Stonehaven should be focussed on space for members to park their boats for sailing rather than winter storage.</li> <li data-bbox="312 1570 1396 1673">• Club members have done well at International events in particular at the Fireball Europeans Donald Smith and Matt Richardson did very well and Tim and Ruth Jones won the Dutch National Wayfarer Championships.</li> <li data-bbox="312 1680 1396 1783">• £1000 was raised by the Lions use of the clubhouse at the Stonehaven Folk festival, this money will go to local charities. The following is highlighted from the open discussion:</p> <ul data-bbox="312 479 1390 1055" style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Could we use the gas board land?</li> <li>• Can make changes in how we store boats.</li> <li>• Looking at racking for Lasers.</li> <li>• Depends on membership for 2006.</li> <li>• There is a farm that could be used for storing boats?</li> <li>• Have used sea cadets shed for 2 years for winter boat storage.</li> <li>• Main problem is storage for going sailing, not winter storage.</li> <li>• Any potential areas in harbour area for boat parking? No-one was aware of any.
