1. General

The Aberdeen and Stonehaven Yacht Club invites all sailors to their summer Regatta. The event is the Scottish Championship for the Fireball Class, the Alba cup for the Laser 2000 Class & Travellers event for the Laser Full & Radial Rig classes & there will be a start for a General Handicap Class.

2. Organising Authority

Aberdeen and Stonehaven Yacht Club will run the Regatta. Racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the RYA, the classes' rules, this notice of race and the sailing instructions.

3. Eligibility

There will be class racing for all classes detailed in section 1 of this Notice of Race, however, classes may be combined during starting and or racing if insufficient competitors enter. There will be handicap racing for any other boats.

4. Advertising on boats and sails

The event is category C.

5. Registration

Competitors will register in the race office on Saturday 30th August 2008 from 09.30 hrs.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at the race office on registration or may be available from the ASYC web site 7 days before the regatta at: www.asyc.org.uk

7. Briefing

There will be a competitors' briefing at **11:30 hrs** on Saturday 30th August 2008.

8. Racing Programme

6 races are scheduled (3 each day) of which 1 shall be completed to constitute a series. The warning signal for the first race on Saturday 30th August 2008 will not be before **12:57 hrs**.

Lunch for competitors to take on the water will be provided as part of the entry fee.

9. Social Programme

There will be a BBQ after racing on Saturday. The BBQ will be started at ca **18:00 hrs**. The ASYC bar will also be open.

10. Courses and Racing Areas

The racing area will be Stonehaven Bay.

11. Liability exclusion

Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for competitors to decide whether their boat is fit to sail in the conditions in which it will find itself. By launching or going to sea competitors confirm the boat is fit for those conditions and they are competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and or competitors, nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the event. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and or competitors of their responsibilities. The boat is required to be adequately insured including insurance against third party claims of at least **£1,000,000**.
